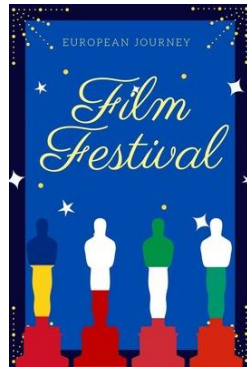


“European Journey”: the culture film festival



Another part of Thomas More’s Erasmus+ portfolio, concerns the project coordinated by the Polish primary school *Maria Konopnicka*: **European Journey - Film Festival**. By strengthening creativity and digital skills, the purpose of this exchange is to stimulate the imagination of primary, middle and high school pupils, by making **three short films (three per partner)**:

- 1) The first film will be dedicated to **History** (local / national);
- 2) The second one will be dedicated to the **environment and local natural attractions** (e.g. parks, forests etc.);
- 3) The last one, will be an adaptation of a famous masterpiece of **Italian literature**.

The realization of the three short movies (length of 15-20 minutes) will be entirely managed by the students: from the production of scripts to the recording and post-production: the aim is to encourage sharing and cooperation between the four partners (Poland, Bulgaria , Romania and us in Italy). The twelve compositions (three per partners) will be accompanied by a thirteenth movie: a sort of “**making of**”, behind the scenes.

The project will culminate its cycle with the final representation of a “**School film festival**” – to be hopefully held in person – to reach three main objectives:

- *Strengthen the teaching potential of schools* by sharing methodologies, approaches and visions of partner countries;
- *Promote values* of tolerance, equality, non-discrimination and international cooperation;
- *Improve language, digital and creative skills* of the participating pupils;

It is a work in Cooperative Learning among students, with the aim of using digital platforms - first of all **eTwinning** - to deal with issues related to the environment, cultural heritage and literature by presenting and sharing culture and traditions of the countries involved.
